ABOUT THE MOTH WORKSHOP

The Moth Community Engagement Program provides the space, tools and expertise for people to practice the art and craft of personal storytelling. As a participant in a Moth workshop, you will have the opportunity to shape a life experience of your choosing into a well-crafted story!

Intensive storytelling workshops with The Moth Community Program are **completely free** for participants and take place over multiple sessions including a final event where you'll have the opportunity to share your story with others.

You will be guided by experienced Moth instructors who will work in small groups with you and your fellow storytellers. You can choose a story from any corner of your life, and you do not need to have your story identified before the workshop begins; brainstorming story ideas is a part of Moth workshops!

During the workshop, you will...

- Get to know your fellow storytellers through trust-building games
- Explore the art and craft of true personal storytelling
- Reflect on your life experiences through a series of prompts
- Identify one personal story you wish to tell
- Craft a five-minute version of that story
- Record and share your story with an invited audience

After completing a workshop, you'll be eligible to **receive special alumni benefits**, including a **SLAM pass** that **provides you and a guest free access** to Moth SLAMS for an entire year.
